The following is only a partial list of the Bethel Christian Schools standards for Personal Appearance during school hours and during off-campus school functions. See the Student Handbook for a complete list.

- * **POLO SHIRTS** – MUST be purchased through the BCS office. No other polo shirts may be worn. **Field trip polos** must be worn for all off-campus outings as follows:

K – 3 rd grades	RED
4 th – 5 th grades	NAVY BLUE
6 th – 12 th grades	MAROON

- * **Plain BUTTON-DOWN SHIRTS/BLOUSES** may also be worn in blue, pink, or white.

- * **Plain PANTS, SHORTS to just above knee**, cotton or cotton blend twill in *BLACK, TAN, or NAVY* in good condition (no rips) and of modest fit (not too tight or too loose). **NO BLUE JEANS**. Waist of pants/shorts to sit above the derriere – no sagging.

Girls may also wear **CAPRIS** and **SKORTS to just above knee**.

- * **JACKETS, outerwear** of any kind but free of 'supernatural' images or slogans that the school considers inappropriate (see below).
- * **SHOES** must be *closed-toe, closed-heel*, with heels of no more than 1 ½ inches high.
- * **JEWELRY** – small *necklaces, rings, bracelets, ear rings*. **NO PINS**. Nothing spiked or pointed.
- * **PIERCINGS** – ears only, no more than 3 holes in each ear, holes less than ½ inch diameter
- * **BELTS** may not have studs, spikes, or buckles larger than 2 inches.
- * **HAIR** – must be natural colors, no extreme styles.
- * **MAKE-UP** – *girls in grades 6-12 only*. No extreme make-up.
- * **BANDANAS/SCARVES** – *girls only*. No inappropriate slogans, designs, etc. (see below). Tied at nap of neck only – no 'pirate,' 'kerchief,' or 'gang-style' wrappings.
- * **PERMANENT/TEMPORARY TATOOS** are to be covered at all times.

Inappropriate slogans/designs: anything racial, political, drug-related, sex-related, anti-Christian, 'supernatural' outside of Christianity (if visible), images of identifiable people, and such like according to the school administration.
